



## **HUNTER DIVISIONS POINT TABULATION**

### **Point Tabulation:**

In "A", "B" or "C" rated hunter sections, points are determined by adding one point for each entry to the base points listed on the increment chart below.

### **Base points per section rating:**

	<b>"C"</b>	<b>"B"</b>	<b>"A"</b>	<b>"AA"</b>
1 <sup>st</sup>	10	15	20	25

Division champions will be awarded 2.0 times the total 1<sup>st</sup> place point value of the first class in that section. The first place point value is the number of entries that competed added to the base points on the chart. For example, in an "AA" section with nine entries that competed in the first class, the Championship for that section would earn 68 points. This is calculated by adding 9 (# of entries that competed) to 25 (1<sup>st</sup> place base points for "AA") and then multiplying the outcome by 2.

**Rated Hunter Divisions:** Green Pony Hunter, Small Pony Hunter, Medium Pony Hunter, Large Pony Hunter, Junior Hunter 3'3", Small Junior Hunter, Large Junior Hunter, Amateur Owner Hunter 3'3", Amateur Owner Hunter, Green Hunter 3' & 3'3", Green Hunter 3'6" & 3'9" and Performance Working Hunter.

**"C" Rated Only Divisions:** Baby Green Hunter, Young Hunter, Low/Pre-Children's Small/Medium Hunter, Low/Pre-Children's Large Pony Hunter, Low/Pre-Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under, Low/Pre-Children's Hunter Horse 15-17, Small/Medium Children's Pony Hunter, Large Children's Hunter Pony, Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under, Children's Hunter Horse 15-17, Low/Pre-Adult Hunter, Adult Amateur Hunter 18-35, Adult Amateur Hunter Over 35, Low Hunter, Modified Hunter, Short Stirrup Equitation, Short Stirrup Hunter, Pony Jumper, Children's Jumper, Adult Amateur Jumper, Side Saddle, High Score TB Performance Award. *These division points are accrued at the "C" rating to ensure balance amongst eligible competitors for high score awards.*

Championship points are based on the total number of horses in the rated classes of the Hunter Breeding Division at the competition:
